



To move up a step, the care giver pushing the wheelchair must step on the tipping bar and push downwards at the handles such that the front wheel castors are raised onto the step. Next pull upwards at the handles to bring up the rear wheels. Do not try to push over the steps by force.




To move up or down a steep slope, ensure that a care giver is around to support the wheelchair, otherwise, the chair may overturn. For a steep downward slope, the wheelchair should be turned to face up slope, and the care giver should back the chair downwards gradually.


When lifting a wheelchair with the patient on it, do not hold on to the handles if the chair's backrest is the foldable kind. Otherwise, the backrest may be damaged.




Do not step on the foot plate when getting off the wheelchair, or else the chair will tip forward.




Do not place the wheelchair near any sources of fire, or else the backrest may be set on fire, resulting in injuries.



USING THE BRAKE


1. For Self Maneuvered Wheelchair




Push both the brake lever downwards to lock the wheelchair, and pull the lever up to release the brake.





- 1. Grasp the handle and lift upwards in the arrow's direction.


CAUTION

1.Do remember to engage the brake even when stopping for a short while, make it a habit to engage brakes.

Brakes at the handles are only for reducing speed. Remember to apply both the brakes simultaneously. To lock the chair, the brake lever must be

- 2. The wheelchair is unable to execute sudden stops, so do not speed while on it.
- 3. When turning at a sharp corner, reduce speed to avoid tipping over.
- 4. Before moving the wheelchair, ensure that the patient has his/her feet on the foot plate.
- 5.Always ensure safety first. If the patient feels unsafe being alone, he/she should ask for assistance before proceeding.




Adjusting the Height of the Foot Plate

Turn the foot plate in the direction of the arrow, and adjust its height. Then tighten the nut at the side of the step pipe with the spanner provided.





Adjusting the Height of the Foot Plate




 Using the spanner, slightly loosen the porion of the step pipe where it is bolted to the foot plate.






 Flip the foot plate upwards in the direction of the arrows.




Lift the centre of the seat up to fold the wheelchair.









Flip the foot plate up whenever getting on or off the wheelchair.



Ensure that foot plate is at least 7cm above the ground. If placed too low. The foot plate will hit obstacles when travelling on uneven ground, causing the wheelchair to be off-balance.



 Hold on to the handle with one hand, and pull the knob backwards with the other.



The handle can now be dropped downwards.
